

Title: Part-Time GIS Internship (Flexible Days & Hours)

Job Description:

The purpose of this position is to assist in pre-field assessments, preliminary research using current and historic images, and create maps as part of a multistage project or stand-alone visual aid.

Intern will create base maps and map packages including property boundary, general location, soil data, historic aeriels, etc. Part of the job will be to establish gridline/point plot surveys for timber cruises as well as wetland and/or stream delineations. Person will also prepare detailed field assessments, reports, and mapping exhibits in the office and the field. This position will primarily focus on computer, file, and data management; however, fieldwork participation will vary depending upon the project. Flexible working hours with task-based projects and independent time management with weekly progress reports and in-person meetings will be required. The applicant must have self-motivation and discipline.

Housing is available and possible travel with overnight stay may be associated with specific jobs.

Qualifications:

- Experience with ESRI Geographic Information Systems software applications is required;
- Computer literacy, especially in the full MS Office suite, Google Earth, and ArcGIS;
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills and ability to multi-task;
- The applicant will be highly motivated, responsible, self-reliant, get along well with others, and be able to work without direct supervision.
